When Michelle Harmel was in the meeting she additionally brought up the disregard of 'NO PARKING' signs at PWP with cars parked all along Meredith drive but not utilizing adjacent parking lot at soccer fields. There is a safety concern and township police will be patrolling with intention on ticketing if visitors to not abide by posted signage.
